## Committee Chairmanships of the Central Coast Caucus Members for 2025

**SACRAMENTO** — Assemblymember Dawn Addis (D-Morro Bay) and Assemblymember Gregg Hart (D-Santa Barbara), the co-chairs of the California Central Coast Legislative Caucus, issued the following statement regarding the new committee chairmanship and leadership appointments of Central Coast Caucus members for the 2025 legislative year:
